

PURPOSE & GOALS

Today's Museum

The Eighth Air Force Museum is located on the edge of Barksdale AFB next to the Bossier North Gate, and is easily accessible by base personnel as well as the public. Founded in 1979, today's museum is housed in a building constructed in 1955.

The museum exhibits were installed in the early 1980s with limited capabilities to update or refresh. Also, 20 historic aircraft have been kept outdoors for 30 years.



Air Force Evaluation

An evaluation by the US Air Force found us deficient in several respects, most particularly the deterioration of aircraft due to outdoor storage. The continued existence of these aircraft and of the museum itself is in jeopardy.

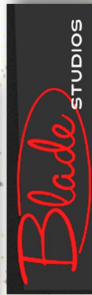
Big Steps Forward and PREServing History

The museum association has been under way for taking steps for a big future for the museum: **(P)**reparation and planning of public presentation materials & conducting feasibility studies to determine support levels of the project. **(R)**enovation, with a complete redesign, fabrication, and installation of modern exhibits for the existing museum. **(E)**xpanding the museum with a conceptual plan of a redesign, expansion, and potential relocation of the current facility with a new modern facility that would potentially be revitalized as

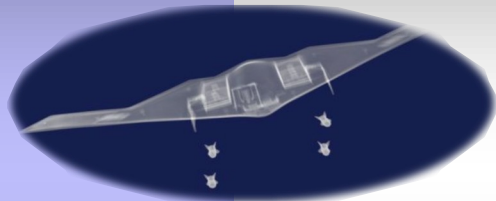
